



2013 KELLER ESTATE ROSÉ

Our 2013 Rose is a wonderful representation of the versatility of pinot noir on our estate. Strawberry and watermelon dominate the nose and continues on the palate with a hint of bright red cherry. Fresh acidity and natural minerality provide for a clean, refreshing finish.

Fruit for the Rose was picked from both our El Coro vineyard as well as the La Cruz vineyard at early ripeness for fresh acidity, low alcohol, and bright red fruit characteristics. Grapes were harvested at 22.5 brix and given 18-24 hours of skin contact for a deep salmon color in the wine. The wine was then fermented in stainless steel drums and inoculated with yeast with no malolactic fermentation. It was then bottled early to capture and maintain the peak fruit freshness.
