Keller Estate 2019 La Cruz Chardonnay

Offers a stark contrast to the Oro de Plata, with luxurious aromas of toasted hazelnut, lemon confit, and baked pineapple. The palate is full of preserved peach, baking spice, and vanilla bean. Another well-made wine for those seeking a more opulent, classic style, drink it over the next 6-8 years.

Nutty, earthy, and toasty, this estate-grown white has a steely undercurrent of pulsing acidity that keeps it vibrant and fresh. Strong flavors of pear highlight a medium-bodied palate of integrated flavors and texture.

Keller Estate 2019 La Cruz Vineyard Pinot Noir

This vineyard-designate is light and soft, with rounded edges of integrated tannin and oak. Citrus, vanilla, stems and forest add to a length of baking spice and cardamom that intrigues and adds to the complexity of this crisp, deep wine.

I loved the nose on the 2019 Pinot Noir La Cruz Vineyard. It has lots of red cherries, mulberry, rose petals, and forest, earthy notes to go with a medium-bodied, seamless, elegant style on the palate. It's well-balanced, has ripe tannins, and a good spine of acidity. It should keep nice for 7-8 years.

Keller Estate 2019 CASA Chardonnay

Fleshy, rounded, and influenced by oak, this approachable white is enjoyable fruit-forward and richly nuanced in brioche and butterscotch. It represents great value for the quality, vintage, and appellation.
